*Dear Student,*

*The Rothberg International School welcomes you to the Summer Ulpan 2018. We are happy to have you here and hope you will enjoy your studies. Please find below some important information about the Ulpan.*

### Finding Your Class

Hebrew studies will take place on the Mount Scopus campus, in the Boyar Building (Rothberg International School) and in other buildings in the university. Class lists according to levels with room numbers will be posted in the Boyar Building (Rothberg International School) 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floor on the first morning of the Ulpan.

**Classes will begin on Thursday, July 26, at 8:30 A.M.**

**On this day you are requested to arrive early in order to find out which class you are studying in.**

Any student whose name does not appear on the class lists may not begin to study in the Ulpan without a referral letter from the Division of Hebrew Language Instruction. Such students must first complete financial registration (Boyar Building, 5<sup>th</sup> floor) in order to obtain the referral letter from the Hebrew Division (Boyar Building, 4<sup>th</sup> floor).

## Participation

- Students should be aware that if they are absent from more than 10% of the lessons this will negatively affect their final grade. Students who are absent from 30% or more of the lessons will not be allowed to take the final exam and will not receive a grade for the course.

**Hebrew Levels:**

In order to advance from one level to another, students must pass their Level Exams with the following minimum grades:

**Levels Aleph-Dalet: 65, Level Heh: 70, Level Vav (exempt) 75**
