Finding Your Class

Hebrew studies will take place on the Mount Scopus campus, in the Boyar Building (Rothberg International School) and in the Faculty of Education Building. Class lists according to levels with room numbers will be posted in the Boyar building (Rothberg International School) on the first morning of the Ulpan.

Classes will begin on Thursday, July 26th, at 8:30 A.M.

On this day you are requested to arrive early in order to find out which class you are studying in.

Any student whose name is not on the class lists may not study in the Ulpan without a referral letter from the Hebrew Division. Such students must first complete financial registration (Boyar 5th floor) in order to obtain the referral letter from the Hebrew Division (Boyar 4th floor).
