Finding Your Class

Hebrew studies will take place on the Mount Scopus campus, in the Boyar Building (Rothberg International School) as well as additional buildings in the university.

Classes will begin on Tuesday, August 6, at 8:30 A.M.

On this day you are requested to arrive early in order to find out which class you have been placed into.

You will be notified by email (the e-mail address in our system) as to your class placement a day prior to the start of the ulpan. If you do not receive an e-mail, please go to the 5th floor (rooms 501-2) to complete registration, and then to the Hebrew offices (rooms 444-447) to receive a note and your class placement.

Please note that students studying in the Scopus Ulpan will be completing only approximately half of an Ulpan level, will not be taking a level exam, and will not be able to enter the next level should they continue studying Hebrew at Rothberg in the future.

Participation

- Class attendance is mandatory.
- Students are required to arrive on time to all classes.
- Students must complete all homework assignments, quizzes and exams.
- Students should be aware that if they are absent from more than 10% of the lessons this will negatively affect their final grade. Students who are absent from 20% or more of the lessons will not be allowed to take the final exam and will not receive a grade for the course.
