Dear Students,

On Monday, May 4th, 2020, the Israeli government issued updated guidelines in a continued effort to contain the spread of COVID-19 in Israel while enabling a gradual and measured return to daily routine:

Step 1: May 4, 2020

- o The 100 m limit of movement from your house has been repealed!
- o Visits to one's immediate family are allowed
- o Crowds of up to 20 people are allowed in an open area
- o Malls and markets are reopening on May 7 (only takeaway for dining)
- Schools have been reopened according to the approved outline
- Tourist sites, nature reserves, parks (without guest facilities) and zoos are open
- Competitive sport and water sports for individuals are allowed. Gyms will open on May 7.
- Guest accommodations and hotels are open (common areas will be closed)

Step 2: May 10, 2020

- o Kindergartens, daycare centers and the like are open
- o Crowds of up to 50 people are allowed in an open area

Continuation of Step 2: May 17, 2020

- o Museums open
- Sports activities without personal contact are allowed for up to 20 people
- Schools opening of grades 4-10 is under consideration

Step 3: May 31, 2020

- o Crowds of up to 100 people are allowed in an open area
- Extracurricular activities for children, informal education and youth movements will open
- o Public areas and playgrounds will open
- Swimming pools will open
- Competitive sports (leagues) will open without audiences (This may be delayed to step 4 – To be decided)
- Restaurants may open (although this will probably happen only in step 4 TBD)
- o Regular opening of Higher Education

Step 4: June 14, 2020

- o Under consideration: cancellation of limit for crowds
- o Movies and theaters reopen
- o Civil aviation (partial) reopens

<u>Hebrew University Libraries update:</u>

The libraries are reopening for loan services only at this stage. Reading halls are closed at the moment. We will update when it changes.
