The Rothberg International School welcomes you to our online Winter Ulpan 2021 (January 28–February 18). **Online Winter Ulpan classes are held Sunday through Thursday (there are no classes on Friday or Saturday).**

Please find below some important information about the Ulpan.

Required Essay

Information regarding the date for writing the essay (this will be done online through zoom) for determining the appropriate Hebrew level, will be sent by email closer to the beginning of the Winter Ulpan.

Purchasing the Hebrew textbook

Once you receive your level, you will be sent an email regarding books purchasing.

Students in Israel can purchase the book at three stores in Jerusalem or order the book online and the book will be shipped to them.

Students who are abroad can order the book online and the book will be shipped to them.

Finding your Class

Close to the beginning of the course (the evening before) you will receive your class placement and the link to the zoom room.

Attendance is mandatory.

• Ulpan Grade and Participation

During the first week, the teachers will explain the breakdown of the final Ulpan grade. The grade consists of the following components: participation, homework, weekly quizzes, oral exam and final exam. Please note the following:

- Class attendance is mandatory. Students are required to arrive on time for all classes.
- Students must complete all homework assignments, quizzes and exams.
- Students who miss more than 10% of their classes without a justified reason will receive a warning letter. Those who miss 20% or more will be allowed to continue the course;

however, they will not be permitted to take the final exam at the end of the course and they will have no grade for the course.

Online Final Exams

Students generally do not complete a whole level during the Winter Ulpan, and at the end of the course take a final exam based on the material studied in class. However, some classes begin in the middle of a given level, and students in these classes will take the Level Exam at the end of the Ulpan. The Level Exam is based on the full curriculum of the level, and those who pass this exam may continue their studies at the next level. Students who wish to take the Level Exam instead of the final exam of their class should consult with the Ulpan coordinator.

The final exam will be held on February 18th.
