PROGRAM.*

This award is offered in the amount of \$3,000 for the Spring semester of study at RIS. To be considered, candidates must be American citizens and accepted to the Spring in Jerusalem Honors program.

Spring in Jerusalem is designed for outstanding students in their third and fourth years of study, with a minimum GPA of 3.7, who are looking for a unique intellectual challenge. Participants study together with Israelis in advanced-level courses offered in English by various departments of the Hebrew University. Hebrew and Arabic language classes are available at different levels of expertise. Students experience Israel through field trips, social encounters with prominent Israelis, supervised internships, independent research projects and a variety of extracurricular activities. Students are required to participate in a series of interdisciplinary Sunday brunch lectures presented by leading Hebrew University faculty members.
