The Merit Scholarship award is offered in the amount of \$6,000 for one year of study or \$3,000 for one semester of study. To be considered, candidates must have completed at least three semesters of university study, have a minimum GPA of 3.8, and must be accepted to the Rothberg International School's Undergraduate Study Abroad program for a single semester or full year.
