**Hebrew for Communications Purposes - Advanced**

Credits: 4

1. Course Objective

The course is designed to impart Advanced level vocabulary and grammar for communication in

a variety of essential daily-life situations in Israel.

2. Course Description

• Comprehension: Listening to stories, recorded conversations and News from Radio and

TV.

• Conversation: Dialogues from everyday life.

• Reading: Dialogues and texts in Hebrew on everyday topics.

• Writing: Short dialogues and passages on the topics taught in class.

• Grammatical Skills: Grammatical structures, inflection of the strong verb in the Future.

3. Examinations

Quizzes will be given on a regular basis.

**Oral Examination** is held at the end of the course. Students are tested on texts taught in class on

topics prepared in advance.

Final Exam will include vocabulary and the grammatical structures taught during the course.

4. Final Grade

The final grade is based on the following:

• Attendance, class participation, homework, quizzes, oral exam: 50% (exact value of each

component is according to the framework of the course).

• Oral Exam: 15%

• Final Exam: 35%

Note: The student must pass the Course with a grade of at least 65.
