**Hebrew for Communications Purposes - Intermediate**

**Course Hours: 56**

**Credits: 4**

### **1. Course Objective**

The course is designed to impart Intermediate level vocabulary and grammar for communication in a variety of essential daily-life situations in Israel.

### **2. Course Description**

- Comprehension: Listening to short stories and recorded conversations.
- Conversation: Simple dialogues and stories.
- Reading: Dialogues and texts in easy Hebrew on various topics.
- Writing: Short dialogues and passages on the topics taught in class.
- Grammatical Skills: Grammatical structures, inflection of the strong verb in the past and present tenses; frequent weak verbs.

### **3. Examinations**

**Quizzes** will be given on a regular basis.

**Oral Examination** is held at the end of the course. Students are tested on texts taught in class on topics prepared in advance.

**Final Exam** will include vocabulary and the grammatical structures taught during the course.

### **4. Final Grade**

The final grade is based on the following:

- Attendance, class participation, homework, quizzes, oral exam: 50% (exact value of each component is according to the framework of the course).
- Oral Exam: 15%
- Final Exam: 35%

Note: The student must pass the Course with a grade of at least 65.
