Description:

Leading up to the spring semester, the pre-semester program offers an intense and electrifying experience for its students through their participation in dance classes and rehearsals in the studios of the JAMD. Each day/session will start with a warm up class to professionally prepare the bodies and minds of the participants. The warmup will always relate strongly to the artist/company whose choreographies will be taught in the following rehearsals.

They will meet, familiarize and deepen their understanding and performance skills of the movement material/language of world-renowned Israeli choreographers such as
