The student housingteam welcomes student initiatives and ideas for activities.



Student Village Rules and Regulations

Check-In: Upon arrival, students must check in with dormitory staff at Building B12 and complete all necessary documents.

Check-Out: Students must check out by the specified end date of their housing lease and return the keys. A charge of \$32 per day will be applied for late check-outs.

Cleaning: Students are required to leave the room clean. A fine will be imposed if the room is not cleaned properly.

Room Inspections: Dormitory staff will conduct regular room inspections to ensure safety and cleanliness.

Damages: Students are responsible for any damage to their rooms or common areas and must pay for repairs.

Guests/Visitors: No overnight guests, including friends, parents, or partners, are allowed.

Pets: Pets are not allowed in the dormitory.

Smoking and Alcohol: Smoking and alcohol consumption are strictly prohibited within the dorm.

Public peace: Quiet must be maintained at all times. Excessive noise in rooms or common areas is prohibited.

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Tips and important information:

1. Hot water in the apartment: Make sure to turn on the boiler an hour in advance to ensure you'll have hot water to take a shower. Don't forget to turn it off.
